Characteristics of a good study plan



- Rationale – why? What leads you to choose that field of study?
- Clear and precise plan – what do you want to study? Subjects? What knowledge and/or skills do you need to do your future job?
- Relevant to educational background / relevant work experience, volunteerism or community service...
- Application upon completion of the study (as detailed as possible)
